Dr. David Griffin, a native of Charleston, SC, and CFD Officer, has a Doctorate of Education in organizational leadership and development, training organizations across the globe on the importance of moving away from "**the way we've always done it**" mentality. He speaks about the Sofa Super Store fire and has helped with massive reforms in how firefighters are trained as well as how executives lead their teams. Griffin has dedicated his life to spreading the message of change to all types of organizations.



Jason Patton is a 12-year career firefighter/paramedic and creator of the video series Fire Department Chronicles which has amassed 1.4 million followers and over 150 million views. Patton is vice president of Fire Department Coffee and a board member and spokesperson for the Heroes Cup, which works with NHL teams such as the Boston Bruins and the Tampa Bay Lighting to raise money for first responders in need. He is an advocate for first responder mental health, attempting to **break the stigma associated with those seeking help** for mental health or substance abuse issues.

The service takes place at the Memorial Site by Capitol Lake. In case of inclement weather, we will have it in the Capitol Building Rotunda.



When tragedy strikes, people call for help. When tragedy strikes a department, Local Assistance State Team (LAST) is their help.




The LAST is a volunteer group of fellow emergency services individuals from our state, and surrounding states, that will

assist a department, and family, with unfortunate incidents involving the loss of a firefighter, EMT, Law Enforcement, or other emergency responder.

They can provide assistance with planning a memorial service for the loss of a current, retired, or longtime member; or a Line-of-Duty Death, with assistance, afterwards, of filing insurance benefits and getting the family back on their feet.
