Jeff Dill is a retired Captain from Palatine Rural Fire Protection District in Inverness, Illinois and is a licensed counselor member of the American Counseling Association and National Board of Certified Counselors.

Jeff is a lead member of the Firefighter Behavioral Health Alliance.

Jeff was a speaker at the spring National Volunteer Fire Council 2023 Wildland Symposium in Rapid City. He and the FBHA team was highly recommended by other Midwest state fire associations.

In 2011, Firefighter Behavioral Health Alliance was organized based on the decreasing funds available for training at the Fire Department level and the staggering number of firefighter suicides. FBHA was established to directly educate firefighters/ Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel and their families about behavioral health issues such as depression, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), anxiety and addictions, as well as firefighter suicides.

Jeff Dill, and those working with FBHA, are dedicated to educating firefighters and emergency service personnel and their families on the importance of behavioral health.






